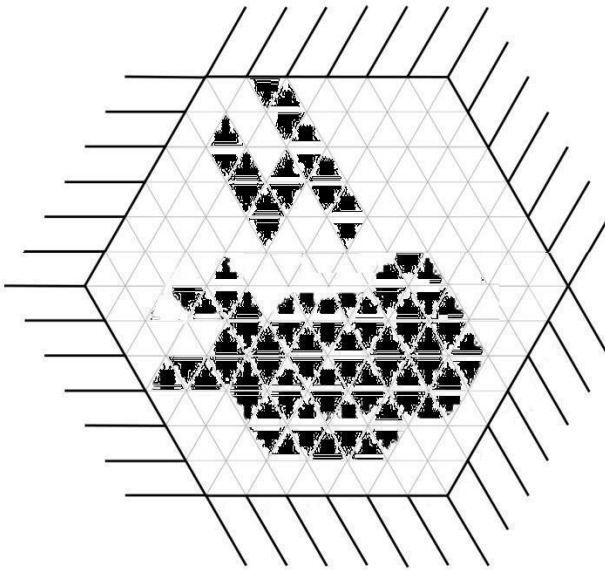

Solve the cryptic clues to associate a Scandinavian country with each of the 5 nonogram grids that you initially receive:

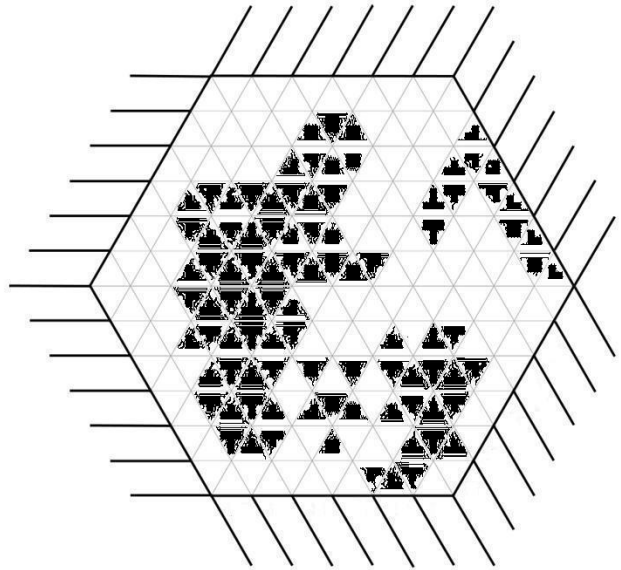
1024 male sheep backing into lair for this country	Denmark

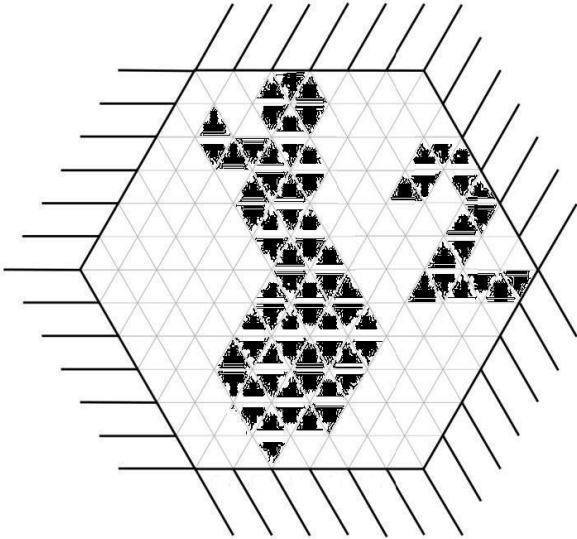
For Sweden:



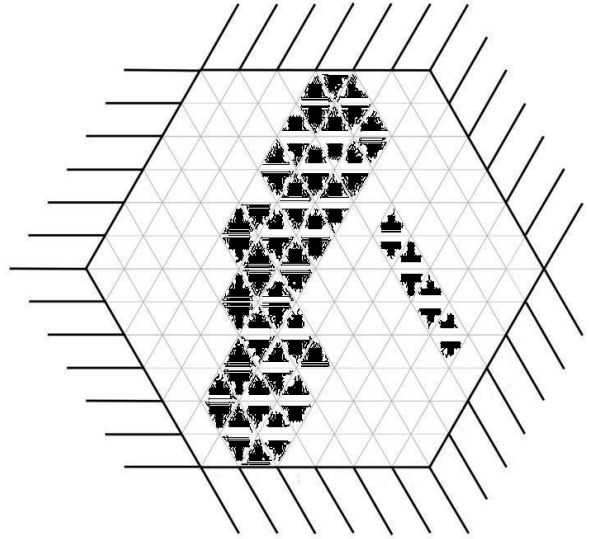
For Norway:



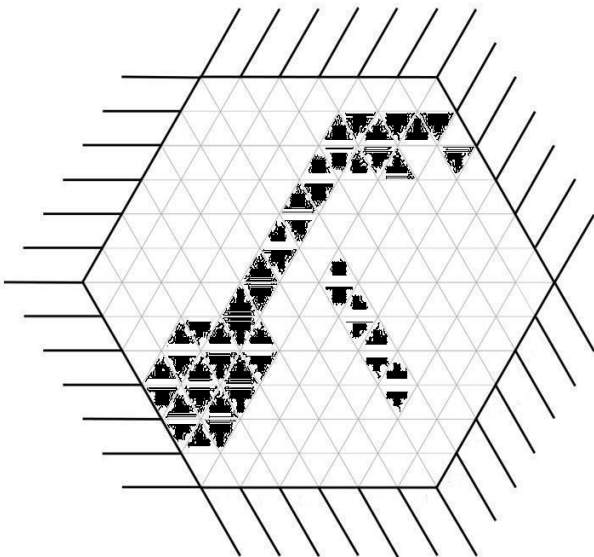
For Iceland:
